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The Trinity of GOD

Before Jesus ascended to heaven, He gathered together with His disciples and said to them:

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the **Father**, and of the **Son**, and of the **Holy Ghost**:

Matthew 28:19

Here we can see that Jesus revealed to His disciples that no body's salvation is secure if it is not coming from the three persons that make up God. Baptizing them He said; in the name of the **Father**, and of the **Son**, and of the **Holy Ghost**:

FATHER

SON

HOLY SPIRIT

We need to understand that without any of these three parts, God will in no way be a completed God. The equation that greatly gives a whole God is:

God the Father + God the Son + God the Holy Spirit = GOD

Let me invite you all to a moment of reasoning, and see what the Bible says about it:

In the book of Genesis 1:26 (1st book of the Holy Bible) God, speaking of creation of mankind, used the word "**let us**", to identify a team that will work under His giving order, which meant: **let Me, God! And any other being that I God give power and authority help in the making of mankind**. This order given by God, plainly revealed to us that God Himself was not alone at the very beginning.

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

Genesis 1:26

God called on other Beings to help Him with the whole creation. I personally believe that these additional Beings were **Jesus-Christ** and the **Holy Spirit**.

According to the book of Genesis, **God** and His **Spirit** started everything in the beginning, it reads:

¹In the **beginning** God created the heaven and the earth.

²And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the **Spirit of God** moved upon the face of the waters. *Genesis 1:1-2*

Now we come to the understanding that not only **God** but also His **Spirit** where there at the beginning - moving upon the face of the waters.

Keep in mind, that all of these actions were taking place in the beginning, and also that the involving actors were acting in the very beginning.

Yet, we so far come down with two Actors, "**God** and His **Holy Spirit**".

To equalize the equation we need to find out if the **Son** was also linking in the creation activities in the beginning.

The 1st verse in the 1st chapter of the book of John said:

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. *John 1-1*



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This portion of the Bible tells us that there isn't any difference between God and the Word, and that the Word was also there at the very beginning. The most amazing and interesting fact, is that verse 14 described Jesus (the Son) as being the Word that was in the beginning:

And the **Word** was made **flesh**, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten Son* of the Father,) full of grace and truth. *John 1-14*

Thus, the Word who was God in the beginning became flesh, meaning God made Himself a body (His Son) where His Soul and His Holy Spirit can inhabit, and that way, God Himself, in the form of Jesus-Christ can be with us and teach us the heavenly truth.

Realize what Jesus replied to Philip, one of His disciple, when he asked the Lord to show him the Father. Let's read what John wrote.

⁸ Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us.⁹ Jesus saith unto him, have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known Me, Philip? He that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?¹⁰ Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? The words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.¹¹ Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake. *John 14:8-11*

But in the entire Bible the Holy Spirit testified about Jesus-Christ being in the presence of the Father before anything ever existed.

Let me read Proverbs 8:22-29, this is a very interesting passage which reveals to us what was in the beginning:

²² The LORD possessed me in the **beginning** of his way, before his works of old.

²³ I was set up from **everlasting**, from the **beginning**, or ever the earth was.

²⁴ When there were no depths, I was brought forth; when there were no fountains abounding with water.

²⁵ Before the mountains were settled, before the hills was I brought forth:

²⁶ While as yet he had not made the earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world.

²⁷ When he prepared the heavens, I was there: when he set a compass upon the face of the depth:

²⁸ When he established the clouds above: when he strengthened the fountains of the deep:

²⁹ When he gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass his commandment: when he appointed the foundations of the earth: *Proverbs 8:22-29*

¹⁶For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: *Colossians 1:16*

¹God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, ²Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; *Hebrew 1:1-2*

With these references, we can conclude that the **Word** who was in the **beginning** and who became flesh is the Son of God.

Therefore the equation **God the Father + God the Son + God the Holy Spirit = GOD** is verified and thus is true. But what I really want you to get your focus on is the fact that God called on Jesus and the Holy Spirit in the making of mankind in their image, He said: "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness". But before jumping into any deep explanation, let's make it clear that God the Father is where all the **thoughts**, **beliefs** and **convictions** reside, which represent the equivalent of the Soul of God. Let us reason together, if God the Father is also the Soul of God. So we can rewrite the equation like this:

- **FATHER** = **SOUL**(of God)
- **SON** = **BODY**(of God)
- **HOLY SPIRIT** = **SPIRIT**(of God)



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Since God is calling on mankind to be created in the likeness of the FATHER, likeness of the SON and the likeness of the HOLY SPIRIT, mankind was created with a SOUL the likeness of the FATHER, a BODY the likeness of the SON and a SPIRIT the likeness of the HOLY SPIRIT.

Therefore, God the Father is the soul of God, so God created the **soul of man**.

The Holy Spirit of God created the **spirit of man**.

The word that became flesh, Jesus the son of God created the **son of man**.

And I declare this statement as being my personal belief, Judge it for yourself if you want, and see what the Lord will reveal to you.

Now understand in the following verse what a man represents to God:

⁷ And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. *Genesis 2:7*

In the **1st book of the Thessalonians** the Apostle Paul, spoken of the making of a whole living being, declared this:

²³ And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your **whole** spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. *1Thessalonians 5:23*

Now we see that according to the Bible, the whole of a living being is made of **soul, body and spirit**, which is the fulfillment of God's giving order in the beginning.

To fully comprehend the liaison between soul, body and spirit, we must know how communication is handled among the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. This mystery of God, is clearly explained in **1Corinthians 2:10**,¹⁰ But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the **Spirit searcheth** all things, yea, the **deep things of God**. Noticeably the Spirit of God search in the mind of God, found the thoughts, beliefs and convictions of God and revealed them to the Son. And the Son in His turn live upon the thoughts, beliefs and convictions of the Father.

When we are reading the rest of the 2nd chapter of the 1st epistle of Paul to the Corinthians, we will understand that the only way for us to comprehend the things of heaven is when we receive the Holy Spirit of God. The same as when people understand the things of this world, it is because they have the spirit of the world. Verse 16 explains to us that we must know the mind of God, and that Jesus is the one that the Holy Spirit revealed the deep things (mind) of God to, and He in His body was doing the will of the Father without sinning. He that way receive the fullness of God the Father and of God the Holy Spirit. Jesus was one hundred percent (100%) God on earth. He, himself had the Soul, Spirit and Body of God, which allowed Him to be the only way to salvation:

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. *John 14:6*

Having the fullness of the Holy Spirit, Jesus was able to reveal to us the deep things of God and as all power was given to Him, He promised to whoever believed in Him, the gift of the Holy Spirit and eternal life

And Jesus came and spoke unto them, saying, all power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. *Matthew 28:18*

Listen carefully, the same relationship that Jesus had with the Father, these relations are also reserved for you. You will ask me how? Well the answer is exactly what you are going to hear: When we accept Jesus, repent and born of water and Spirit, we are renewed by the blood of the Lamb of God, and therefore we receive the Holy Spirit of God, which in His turn will reveal to us the deep thoughts, beliefs and convictions of God. And us being knowledgeably connected with God via the Holy Spirit, speak and act accordingly in our body.

Make no mistake, when we get renewed by the Holy Spirit, we will evidently think as God do and act as Jesus did. So our entire self: soul (**where our thoughts, beliefs and convictions are**), body (**where our thoughts, beliefs and convictions are outwardly**)



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manifested), and spirit (where liaison between soul and body takes place), will be transformed by the Soul, Body and Spirit of God. Transformed by the soul of God, when the Holy Spirit reveals the mind of the Lord to you and you decide to think in the same manner. Transformed by the Body of God, when you accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior, take up your cross and become as obedient as the Son was to the Father. Transformed by the Holy Spirit when your heart love the things of God, and allowing the liaison between God's mind (thoughts, beliefs and convictions) and your soul. When all the thoughts, beliefs and convictions of God become your thoughts, your beliefs and your convictions.

¹⁴ *But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.*

¹⁵ *But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.*

¹⁶ *For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.* **1 Corinthians 2:14-16**

*Little children, even though the Bible said that we have the mind of God, we must be careful to do not let ourselves get into any of the Devil's traps, he also is trying to work in the same fashion as God, but using very opposite methods. When for example God said **love**, Satan said **indifference**, God declared **hope**, Satan promote **despair**, when the Lord God proclaimed faith Satan in his way propose **fear**, **and when you fear you lose trust, and when you lose trust you start questioning, and when you start questioning you build doubt, and when doubt overwhelms, you become someone who believes in nothing** (atheist). Remember, that God and Satan are both Spirits, and this is the only way we can compare them. God is indefinitely different. My God can bless five loaves and two fishes and feed nearly five thousand men. My God can speak to a ball of dust and make up a livable planet, whereas Satan can only use his evil way (lies), to convince mankind on revolting against God. If anyone let Satan influence their mind with his own thoughts, beliefs and convictions, that person will be doomed forever along with Satan and his angels.*

The mission that the Lord assigned to the Apostles was perfectly clear:

¹⁵ *And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.*

¹⁶ *He that believes and is baptized shall be saved, but he that believes not shall be condemned.* **Mark 16:15-16**
